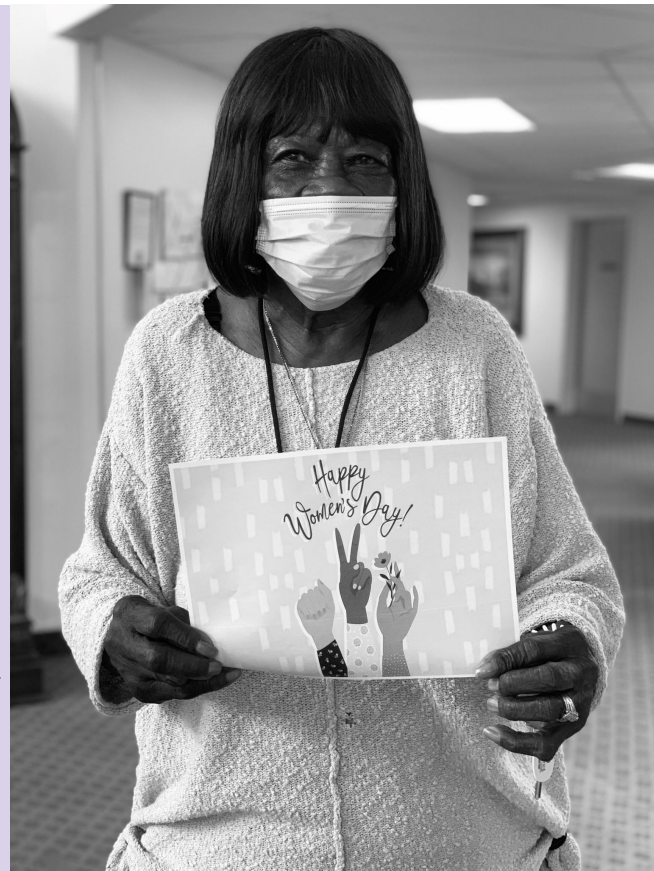


We dedicate our Solstice Spotlight to:

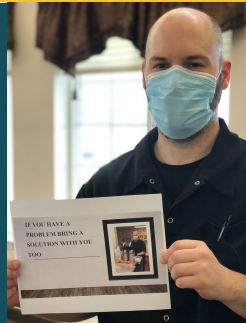
June is the month with the longest daylight hours of the year in the Northern Hemisphere.
